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I. INTRODUCTION

The Pan American Kungfu and Taijiquan Championships (PAKTC) is the highest-level Pan American competition for traditional kungfu and taijiquan. Established in 2015, it showcases the diversity of traditional kungfu forms across bare-hand and weapons styles, alongside the internal martial discipline of taijiquan and its distinct schools.

Hosted by the Argentine Wushu Kung Fu Federation (FAWK) under the auspices of the Pan American Wushu Federation (PAWF), the 5th PAKTC will be held in Buenos Aires, Argentina, from October 5-10, 2026, with competition days on October 8-9. This marks the first time Argentina has hosted the PAKTC. The FAWK has previously organized the Pan American Wushu Championships (PAWC) in 1996, 2010, and 2018, and will host the PAWC alongside the 5th PAKTC during the same week in 2026.

Representatives from the 24 PAWF member countries will compete in the 5th PAKTC. Preceding competition, the PAWF Executive Board Meeting will be held on October 6th and the PAWF Congress on October 7th.

B. PARTICIPATION METHODS

1. Each country / territory may enter one (1) team.
2. Each team shall be composed of maximum of one (1) team leader, four (4) coaches, and one (1) doctor, with no limit on number of athletes:
3. Each competitor may participate in a maximum of:
 - a. two (2) Individual Events
 - b. one (1) Duilian Event
 - c. one (1) Jiti Event
4. Each team may at most enter one Duilian event team per age group. No gender restrictions apply.
5. Each team may at most enter one Jiti event team. Jiti routines may be comprised of athletes from different age groups. No gender restrictions apply.
6. Each competitor should bring along with them a valid Health Certificate (including electrocardiogram, pulse and blood pressure) issued within 60 days prior to the start of the competition signed by a qualified doctor and a Life Accidental Injury Insurance Certificate. All competitors are required to submit a completed and signed waiver of liabilities form, which has been signed by the competitor's parent or legal guardian.

C. COMPETITION METHODS

1. Competition includes Individual Events, Duilian Events, and Jiti Events.
2. Unless otherwise stated within these regulations, the competition will be conducted in accordance with the "Traditional Wushu Competition Rules and Judging Methods (Trial) 2019".
3. Time Limits:
 - a. Traditional Chen-style Taijiquan, Traditional Yang-style Taijiquan, and other Traditional Taijiquan: 3 to 4 minutes
 - b. 42 Taijiquan: 5 to 6 minutes
 - c. 42 Taijijian: 4 to 5 minutes
 - d. 24 Taijiquan: 4 to 5 minutes
 - e. All other Taijijian and Weapons Routines: 3 to 4 minutes
 - f. Shaolin Routines: 40 seconds to 1 minute 30 seconds
 - g. Other Northern Style Barehand and Weapons Routines: 40 seconds to 1 minute 30 seconds



- h. All Southern Style Barehand and Weapons Routines: 40 seconds to 1 minute 30 seconds
 - i. All Jiti (Group Routines): 3 to 4 minutes
 - j. There is no time requirement for other events.
4. Accompanying music is required for all Group A & Group B Taijiquan-style routines (Taijiquan, Taijijian, & Taijishan) which must be uploaded through the online form available at link that will be provided by the LOC with each team's final entry submission. Music is not required for compulsory Taijiquan or Taijijian routines. Music with vocals and lyrics is not permitted.
5. The power of interpretation of the Rules rests solely with the PAWF.

D. COSTUMES AND EQUIPMENT

1. Competitors shall wear Wushu competition uniforms in compliance with the Rules during all events. This must be brought & prepared by the competitors themselves.
2. All weaponry must conform to the requirements as stipulated in the Rules. This must be provided by the competitors.

E. PLACING & AWARDS

The awarding ratios will be based on the actual number of athletes registered in an event and a rounding method shall be implemented.

Individual and Duilian Events Awards

1. First Category Prize awarded to 20% of the athletes.
2. Second Category Prize awarded to next 20% of the athletes.
3. Third Category Prize awarded to next 30% of the athletes

Category Prize recipients will be awarded a medal and a category certificate.

If there are five (5) participants or fewer in any event-age category, the category may be combined with others. Characteristic similarity of the styles, ages, etc. will be considered when events are combined.



Group Events Awards

1. 1st Place awarded to the highest scoring team
2. 2nd Place awarded to the second highest scoring team
3. 3rd Place awarded to the third highest scoring team

Each team member will be awarded a certificate and the appropriate medal



VIII. QUALIFICATIONS

A. MEMBERSHIP

Only National Federations/Associations that have paid their 2025 and 2026 PAWF annual membership fees shall be recognized and eligible to participate.

New PAWF member federations may be invited to participate in the 5th PAKTC after their membership applications have been approved by the PAWF Executive Board.

Athletes from countries that do not have a PAWF-recognized member federation may participate, subject to approval by the PAWF.

B. NATIONALITY

Athletes must be citizens or permanent residents of the country / territory they represent.

Athletes holding dual nationality may represent only one (1) country / territory during the Championships.

In cases where athletes have changed their citizenship, such athletes are required to have resided in the country or territory that they are representing for at least two (2) years prior to the opening day of the competition or activity, during which time they may not have represented any other country or territory in any international competition.

In accordance with these rules and the Olympic Charter, the PAWF Technical Committee will handle all athlete eligibility disputes and submit them to the PAWF Executive Board for a final decision.



IX. REGISTRATION

A. PRELIMINARY ENTRY

The Preliminary Entry Form must state the number of athletes as accurately as possible so the LOC may prepare accordingly.

The Preliminary Entry and formal requests for visa invitation letter must be filled in the online form indicated below no later than 24:00 (Argentina Time) July 15th, 2026.

B. FINAL ENTRY

All Final Entries must be submitted through the Final Registration Form provided by the LOC to all National Federations.

Final Entry Deadline is 24:00 (Argentina Time) on August 15th, 2026.

Submission of the Final Registration Form containing all sections completed in full, including registration of athletes' Degree of Difficulty Techniques and final arrival / departure details, must be sent by email to the 5th PAKTC Organizing Committee (sifucarlosdiaz@yahoo.com.ar).

C. POST-DEADLINE ENTRIES OR CHANGES

After the Final Entry deadline, any information change (including late entry) will be handled as follows:

- Late entries are subject to the approval of the PAWF and, if accepted, are subject to a late-entry fee of US \$100 per athlete.
- Replacing athletes is subject to approval of the PAWF and, if accepted, is subject to a replacement fee of US \$100 per athlete.
- Changes due to incorrect or missing registration information are subject to PAWF approval and, if accepted, are subject to a change fee of US \$100.
- Fees must be paid to the PAWF Secretariat before the Opening Ceremony.

X. ARRIVAL & ACCREDITATION

A. Arrival

All teams are required to register with the 5th PAKTC Organizing Committee at the designated Accreditation Center no later than 22:00 (Argentina Time) on October 6th, 2026 and should stay until October 10th, 2026.

All judges are encouraged to register with the 5th PAKTC Organizing Committee at the designated Accreditation Center no later than 21:00 (Argentina Time) on October 6th, 2026, to attend the PAWF Judges Course and rehearsal judges' activities.

Hotel check-in is after 15:00 (Argentina Time), and accommodations should be booked accordingly (e.g. Teams wishing to check-in on October 6th before 15:00 must have booked their accommodations beginning on October 6th, 2026).

B. Accreditation

Accreditation Center will open at 09:00 on October 5th, 2026. At the Accreditation Center, the Team Leader is required to complete the following registration process with the Organizing Committee:

1	Verify and confirm Final Registration Form with all registration information
2	Present each team member's passport
3	Submit two (2) national flags (size: 1m*2m)
4	Submit national anthem (short version) in MP3 format
5	Submit valid Medical Certificates for all athletes
6	Submit valid life accidental injury and liability insurance certificates
7	Submit signed Waiver of Liabilities for each delegation member (Appendix 1)
8	Pay the relevant participation fees in full (if applicable)
9	Pay the relevant penalty fees in full (if applicable)
10	Confirm all the above items are completed and sign off with LOC

Accreditation badges will be issued to the team leader upon completion of the registration process. Badges must always be worn throughout the event and may be requested by Championships officials or security personnel.

The training schedule will be announced after accreditation has concluded.



XI. TECHNICAL MEETING

The 5th PAKTC Technical Meeting will take place at 09:00 on October 7th, 2026. Each team should send 1-3 representatives to attend the meeting.

The Technical Meeting content will be presented as follows:

- PAWF Event Guidelines (PAWF representatives)
- Event Logistics Information (Organizing Committee representatives)
- Event Technical Details (PAWF Technical Committee representatives)
- Other matters

XII. DRAWING OF LOTS

The Drawing of Lots will be conducted by representatives of the Organizing Committee and the PAWF Technical Committee at 09:30 on October 7th, 2026. Each team should send one to two (1-2) representatives to attend the session.

The PAWF Technical Committee will draw lots on behalf of teams if the team representatives are absent from the session.



XIII. AWARDS & CERTIFICATES

A. Awards Ceremony

- Athletes who win medals shall receive their awards at the conclusion of each competition session.
- If a medalist is unable to attend the awards ceremony for a valid reason, the medal may be collected by an official representative of the respective team. Athletes absent from the awards ceremony without a valid reason shall forfeit their right to receive the medal.
- Team leaders, coaches, doctors, observers, and team members must remain within the designated area and are prohibited from entering the awards presentation platform or otherwise disrupting the awards ceremony.

B. Certificate of Participation

- All team members, including Team Leaders, Coaches, Team Doctors, and Athletes, shall receive a Certificate of Participation.
- The Team Leader shall collect the Certificates of Participation for the entire team from the Organizing Committee.



XIV. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS & JURY OF APPEALS

A. JUDGES (REFEREES)

1. APPOINTMENT OF JUDGES

Each team may submit qualified Kungfu and Taijiquan judges to officiate at the 5th PAKTC (subject to PAWF Technical Committee approval). All judges of the 5th PAKTC must hold a valid IWUF International Judge License or PAWF Continental Judge License at the time of competition.

The PAWF Technical Committee will appoint independent judges at its discretion to serve at the 5th PAKTC in conjunction with the Local Organizing Committee.

2. REGISTRATION

Information for judges selected by teams must be submitted at the time of team registration.

3. PAWF JUDGES TRAINING COURSE

All judges must attend the Judges Refresher Course unless granted an exception by the PAWF Technical Committee. The purpose of this course is to ensure that judges possess a thorough knowledge and understanding of the competition rules, thereby enhancing transparency and objectivity in judging.

4. JUDGES UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

All judges shall provide their own standard judging uniform, consisting of black trousers, white collared shirt, and black shoes. Organizing Committee will provide the official event insignia, as well as an official Championships tie for male judges and an official Championships neck scarf for female judges. Both items shall bear the Championships logo.



B. JURY OF APPEALS AND APPEALS PROCEDURES

The Jury of Appeals and appeals procedures shall be subject to the relevant provisions of “Traditional Wushu Competition Rules and Judging Methods (Trial) 2019”.

XV. SUPERVISORY COMMISSION

A 5th PAKTC Supervisory Commission shall be established by the PAWF, with the purpose of and the right to resolve any disputes or investigate any issues that arise during the course of the 5th PAKTC to ensure the smooth execution of the competition.

The Supervisory Commission for a PAWF Pan American Championships consists of three to five (3-5) members appointed by the President of the PAWF and is responsible for overseeing Championships management and dispute mediation for the entire duration of the Championships and not beyond. Specific descriptions of responsibilities include:

- The Commission will ensure that Championships adhere to principles of fair play, impartiality, and transparency.
- The Commission represents the PAWF in handling disputes regarding the Championships that arise between National Federations (NFs) and/or teams and/or the LOC and has the right to resolve such disputes. However, the Commission does not interfere with the competition proceedings or disputes arise within the competition, which are responsibility of Jury of Appeals and relevant judging panel.
- The Commission represents the PAWF in coordinating between NFs and/or teams and/or the LOC.
- The Commission shall report any irregularities or violations observed during the Championships to the PAWF President and the PAWF Executive Board.
- The Commission shall monitor and demand that NFs take responsibility for their athletes’ general attitude and comportment.



XVI. ACCOMMODATION

A. Accommodation Reservation

All teams are required to lodge at the official hotel as arranged by the Organizing Committee.

The Organizing Committee will arrange accommodation and local transportation for all teams from October 5 to October 10. Teams wishing to arrive earlier or depart later than the required dates should provide the dates for the intended duration of stay during the final registration process. Teams must ensure to book accommodations accordingly, with daily rates applying for extended stays and taking the hotel check-in time of 15:00 into consideration.

B. Official Hotels

The LOC official accommodation is the Sheraton Buenos Aires Hotel & Convention Center which provides convenient direct access to the competition venue halls.

- Check-in is at 15:00, Check-out is at 11:00.
- Included services: Buffet breakfast, high-speed Wi-Fi, access to hotel facilities including gym and swimming pool (tennis and padel courts are available at additional cost), and transportation between airport & hotel.
- Lunch and dinner are not included.

XVII. TRANSPORTATION

The Organizing Committee will provide transportation between the official airports (EZE, AEP) and the official hotel for both arrivals and departures.

To ensure proper arrangements, each participating team must submit complete and accurate travel information by the final registration deadline of August 15th, including:

- List of travelers
- Arrival date and time
- Departure date and time
- Arrival and departure airport
- Airline & Flight number
- Any additional information deemed necessary to facilitate transportation arrangements by the Local Organizing Committee

XVIII. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

A. RATES & SERVICES PROVIDED

Participation fees cover all registration and accreditation-related expenses, accommodation, daily breakfast, and local transportation (airport pick-up and drop-off). All teams shall pay their participation fees in full to the 5th PAKTC Organizing Committee.

B. PARTICIPATION FEES

XIX. PASSPORT & VISA SUPPORT

Teams that require visa invitation letters should state their visa requests in the Preliminary Entry Form through the link below by 24:00 (Argentina Time) on July 15th, 2026. FAWK will provide official support for visa processing at Argentine consulates.



XX. RESPONSIBILITY OF NFs

NFs are responsible for their officials, coaches, athletes, and observers adhering to the IWUF, PAWF and PAKTC principles and to all relevant rules established by the PAWF and Organizing Committee. NFs should ensure that their participants hold themselves to the highest standards in all their actions during the event.

A. FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES

All NFs' Team members participating in the 5th PAKTC must observe and respect the IWUF and PAWF constitution, rules, regulations, and representatives. Individuals deemed to have acted against the PAWF, its principles, interests or purpose may be subject to suspension or expulsion from the event and/or cancellation of their accreditation.

B. ATTITUDE OF ATHLETES

The athletes will compete under the responsibility of their NFs. NFs are fully responsible regarding the general attitude and comportment of their athletes.

C. IMAGE OF ATHLETES

Each NF is responsible for obtaining the rights for the IWUF, PAWF and LOC to use its athletes' images at the discretion of the IWUF, PAWF and LOC for promotional purposes in all forms.

D. INSURANCE & LIABILITY

Each National Federation (NF) is solely responsible for insuring its officials, coaches, athletes, and observers against injury, illness, and third-party liability during their stay in Buenos Aires, Argentina.

The PAWF and the Organizing Committee are not responsible, in whole or in part, for any medical expenses or other liabilities arising from accidents during the 5th PAKTC which shall be the sole responsibility of the participants and their respective teams.
